As we approach mid-summer, I hope that you have enjoyed being with family and friends and been able to stay in the cool provided by air conditioning!

I want to let you know that I will be away for the next four to six weeks following disc surgery on my neck. My doctor has told me that I should not talk on the phone for up to two weeks and my voice could be two months, or more, before returning to normal.

Also, for the first three weeks, I will be on a limited diet broth, soup, and soft foods. I admit that I did laugh when he said, "and then you will graduate to oatmeal." I like oatmeal, but I never thought about it in a manner of a goal.
