**The Weekly Bible Study with The Reverend Ed:** The Bible Study will continue September 22<sup>nd</sup> at 9:15 AM. we will discuss Mark 9:38-50, the stumbling block. On Sunday, September 29<sup>th</sup> we will discuss Mark 10:2-16, divorce and blessing children.

**The Tuesday Morning Book Study** will continue "Meeting Jesus Again for the First Time" by Marcus Borg on Tuesday, September 24<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 AM. We will discuss the second chapter. The New York Times described Marcus Borg as, "A leading figure in his generation of Jesus scholars." 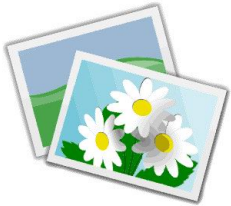
